

HUNTING SEASON REGULATIONS 2017-2018

STLLAGUAMISH TRIBAL HUNTING OPEN IN GMU'S

203, 218, 244, 245, 249, 336, 346, 407, 410, 411, 412, 413, 414, 415, 416, 417, 418, 420, 421, 426, 437, 448, 450, 454, 460, 466, 485, 490, 627, 653

Without waiving any claim or legal argument with respect to the nature, scope or geographic extent of the Stillaguamish Tribe's Treaty hunting rights, the eastern border of that area that will be open for hunting will be the Pacific Crest Trail or the eastern borders of Whatcom, Skagit, Snohomish, King and Pierce counties, whichever is furthest east.

BIG GAME

DEER

Limit up to 3 (three): After successful harvest and reporting of the first 2 permits, a third permit may be issued

Sept. 1/17 - Jan. 31/18 Either sex in GMU'S 203, 218, 244, 245, 249, 407, 410- 418, 426, 437, 448, 450, 460, 466, 490, 627

Sept. 1/17 - Dec. 31/17 Buck only in GMU'S 336, 346, 485, 653

ELK

Limit of 1 (one)

Sept. 1/17 - Jan. 31/18 Either sex in GMU'S 407, 450, 454

Feb. 1/18 - March 31/18 Bull only in GMU's 407, 450, 454

Sept. 1/17 - Dec. 31/17 Bull only in GMU'S 245, 249, 336, 346, 460, 466, 485, 490, 653

Sept. 1/17- March 31/18 Bull only in GMU 437

*Sept. 1/17 - Feb. 28/18 Bull only in GMU 418 (by special permit only)

Do not shoot elk with collars regardless of GMU

BEAR

Limit of 4 (four)

May 1/17 – Nov. 30/18 either sex (avoid shooting sow with cubs)

COUGAR

Limit of 2 (two)

May 1/17 – March 31/18 either sex

SPECIAL PERMITS

*A special elk hunt in GMU 418 will occur for the 2017-18 hunting season. Only permit holders for GMU 418 can take an elk from this GMU. GMU 418 permit holders are also authorized to hunt in elk area 4941. Special permits in GMU 418 may consist of subsistence or ceremonial permits.

**Mountain goats are closed to subsistence hunting. Ceremonial permit may be issued for males only.

***Ceremonial hunts for all big and small game are year round and any sex, unless specified.

Fox	Sept. 1/17 - Apr. 30/18	no limit	
Coyote	Jan. 1/17 - Dec. 31/17	no limit	
Beaver/muskrat	Nov. 1/17 - March 31/18	10 each per year (ten)	10
Ducks	Oct. 1/17 - March 10/18	10 per day (ten)	20

*daily limits on ducks shall include no more than:

- (a) 7 (seven) mallards, of those seven only 3 (three) may be female
- (b) 3 (three) pintail
- (c) 3 (three) redhead
- (d) 3 (three) scaup
- (e) 3 (three) canvasback

Geese	Oct. 1/17 - March 10/18	6 per day (six)	12
Coot	Oct. 1/17 - Jan. 31/18	25 per day (twenty five)	50
Snipe	Oct. 1/17 - Jan. 31/18	10 per day (ten)	20

TRIBAL LANDS

All Stillaguamish Tribal lands in Snohomish County west of HWY 9 are archery, muzzleloader, shotgun and pistol only, unless otherwise posted or by Council Resolution.

The eighty-acre property on 55th Ave. owned by the Tribe is archery only.
