

PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS

Violation in the 4th degree

Persons found guilty of a violation in the 4th degree shall be subject to a fine up to but no more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

Violation in the 3rd degree

Persons found guilty of a violation in the 3rd degree shall be subject to a fine of no more than \$500.00 but no less than \$250.00 and subject to loss of hunting privileges for 1 (one) year.

Violation in the 2nd degree

Persons found guilty of a violation in the 2nd degree shall be subject to a fine of no more than \$1000.00 and no less than \$500.00, up to a 2 (two) year suspension of hunting privileges and confiscation of game and equipment.

Violation in the 1st degree

Persons found guilty of a violation in the 1st degree shall be subject to a fine of \$1000.00, loss of hunting privileges up to 5 (five) years and up to 6 (six) months in jail. All equipment and game will be confiscated.

NOTE: All equipment and game that is confiscated becomes property of the Stillaguamish Tribe.

(A) Equipment shall be kept until Council can decide to auction, keep or possibly return it to the owner.

(B) Game that is confiscated shall be kept and butchered until Council decides to distribute it amongst the elders or return it to the owner.

(C) If person is found not guilty or the charges are dropped, then the game and equipment shall be returned to the owner.
